1. Older People
2. People who are socially isolated
3. People with sensory, mobility or dexterity impairments
4. People who have mental health conditions
5. People with English as a second language
6. People with learning difficulties

For organisations we have a grant pot of £100 - £500 available to help with any additional cost

**We are also looking for organisations to get involved and help us deliver presentations at different events and have a grant available for this.**

The grants scheme is available, for any work that is above and beyond what organisations would do normally (for example we would pay for any additional cost involved in extending your existing meeting for an extra half an hour, volunteer or staff time and general expenses)

The grant is for anything between: £100 - £500 with a maximum of between £50 and £80 per event. We are looking for organisations to add a presentation about the digital switchover onto an existing event (general meeting, coffee morning, AGM, club meeting), and attend a 2 hour training session which can take place at your location (we will come

to you) on how to deliver these presentations which will also inform you about the switchover, the Switchover Help Scheme and its benefits. This training session can be attended even if an organisation does not want to apply for a grant.

All training and materials are provided free of charge and we have an application pack that can be sent out on request.
